SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 222

Commending the East Rockingham High School girls tennis team.

WHEREAS, the East Rockingham High School girls tennis team is expertly coached by Alissa Michael and Kayla Koslow, who dedicated many hours to guiding and mentoring the team, always focusing on developing and improving the players' skills; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend the East Rockingham High School girls tennis team for winning the 2011 Virginia High School League Group A state competition; and, be it
