Commending Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization of America, Inc.

WHEREAS, a yearlong celebration of Hadassah's 100th anniversary, involving conferences, festivals, films, lectures, concerts, parties, religious services, and organization of trips to Israel, will be held throughout the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate of Virginia, That Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization of America, Inc., hereby be commended on the occasion of its centennial; and, be it
