- **5. Summary:** Withdrawal from certain interstate agreements and commissions; Southern Growth Policies Agreement; Education Commission of the States; Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin. The bill has a delayed effective date of July 1, 2013.
- **6. Budget Amendment Necessary**: Yes. If Virginia is required to withdraw from membership in the Southern Growth Policies Board, the savings from not paying annual membership dues are expected to be (\$48,937) GF.

However, Item 473.E. of Chapter 890 already captures savings from the withdraw from the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin (\$151,500) GF and the Governor's introduced budget for 2012-2014 (HB/SB 30, Item 471) captures savings from the withdrawal from the Education Commission of the States (\$91,800) GF.
