4. Title: Hospital discharge of certain minors; information on services available.

5. Summary: Provides that before a hospital discharges a patient, it shall, to the extent allowed pursuant to state and federal law, inform and educate the patient, and his family when it is involved in decision making or ongoing care, about his follow-up care, treatment, and services. In addition, the bill requires community services boards to provide information to hospitals about alcohol and substance abuse services available to minors.
