4. Title: Compensation and fringe benefits

5. Summary: The bill would require that any modifications to the compensation or fringe benefits of state employees apply equally to the compensation and fringe benefits of members of the General Assembly. The bill further provides that any increase in the compensation of members of the General Assembly be in accordance with the provisions of Article IV, Section 5 of the Constitution of Virginia. The bill also states that no such increase shall become effective prior to February 1 immediately following the general election of the Senate of Virginia.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

8. Fiscal Implications: DPB cannot estimate any fiscal impact associated with this bill. Any such fiscal impact would depend on future modifications to the compensation or fringe benefits of state employees.
