**4. Title:** COPN; establishing a psychiatric service and adding psychiatric inpatient beds in Planning District

**5. Summary:** Directs the Commissioner of Health to accept applications and review such applications in any certificate of public need Batch Group C review cycle, and authorizes the Commissioner to issue a certificate of public need for the establishment of a psychiatric service and the addition of up to 30 psychiatric inpatient beds in Planning District 20.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact of this legislation is minimal. This legislation could generate \$1,000 in additional revenue for the Virginia Department of Health. The additional revenue comes from the minimum fee assessed and collected for the Certificate of Public Need application.

This legislation does not create a fiscal impact for the Department of Medical Assistance Services.
