5. Summary:

The proposed legislation deals with the situation of an adult taken into custody on the charge of committing a delinquent act when he was a juvenile. The bill provides that the person may be released on bail or recognizance in accordance with the Code provisions dealing with bail or recognizance for adult offenders, rather than those for juvenile offenders.

8. Fiscal Implications:

The proposed legislation specifies which bail and recognizance procedures are to be used in certain situations. It is not expected to have any fiscal impact on state agencies.
