4. Title: Preschool programs; private funding.

5. Summary: Allows a locality to use local or other non-state expenditures, including funding from private sources, which may have conditions agreed to by both parties, for the purpose of meeting its local match requirement in order to apply for a state matching grant to serve eligible four-year-olds.

Fiscal Implications: This legislation allows a local school division to use expenditures supported by private funds to meet its local match requirement for the Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI) program. It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact; however, it could result in savings for local school divisions if the private funds are used to supplant local funds for the purpose of meeting the local match requirement for the VPI program.
