4. Title: Child-placing agency; conscience clause

5. Summary: The proposed legislation stipulates that private child-placing agencies are not required to consider or consent to any placement of a child for foster care or adoption if such placement would conflict with the religious tenets of an agency's sponsor or any organization or institution with which the agency is associated or affiliated. The bill also provides that such refusal would not form the basis of any claim for damages.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this bill would only affect private child placing agencies and their placement of children for foster care or adoption. It is not expected to impact existing staff workloads in the Department of Social Services or require a change to current regulations.
