**4. Title:** Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act; not applicable to certain records

**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill excludes personal information systems maintained by the Department of Social Services related to child welfare, adult services or adult protective services, or public assistance programs from the provisions of the Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act. Therefore, requests for personal information previously made to the Department of Social Services would be handled by the appropriate local department of social services.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The proposed bill codifies current practice since local departments of social services (as the custodians of the data) ultimately provide the information related to the requests addressed in this legislation. Therefore, this bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact.
