4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control (ABC); suspension of license for local tax delinquency.

5. Summary: Provides that upon receipt by the ABC Board of a notice certified by the treasurer, commissioner of the revenue, or finance director of any locality that a licensee of the ABC Board is delinquent in the payment of any taxes, penalties, or interest lawfully imposed by the locality, and who does not have presently pending a bona fide application or appeal with respect to such taxes, penalties, or interest, the ABC Board shall suspend the license until such taxes, penalties, or interest are paid in full.
