**4. Title:** Hiring preference for surviving spouses and children of veterans

**5. Summary:** The bill would add any surviving spouse or child of a veteran killed in the line of duty to the hiring preference in state employment for veterans. The bill defines a child to mean a person under the age of 27 years.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** There are a number of issues and questions concerning this preference that could result in additional administrative costs to the Department of Human Resource Management. However, at this point in time DPB cannot estimate the potential fiscal impact associated with this bill with precision.
