**2. Patron:** Cole

**3. Committee:** Passed both Houses

**4. Title:** Concealed handgun permit; failure to produce upon demand of a law-enforcement officer, penalty.

**5. Summary:** Provides that failure to produce, upon demand of a law-enforcement officer, a concealed handgun permit and a government-issued photo identification while carrying a concealed handgun is punishable by a \$25 civil penalty. A court may waive this penalty if the person presents a valid concealed handgun permit and government-issued photo identification to the court. The bill also introduces an affirmative defense of having a valid concealed handgun permit to a charge of violating the concealed weapons statute.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of State Police does not anticipate a fiscal impact due to the proposed legislation.

Also, the amount of revenue paid to the state treasury (generated by the imposed \$25 civil penalty) cannot be determined.
