4. Title: Use of handheld personal communications devices; penalty.

5. Summary: Prohibits any use of a handheld personal communications device while operating a motor vehicle, bicycle, electric personal assistive mobility device, electric power-assisted bicycle, or moped on the highways in the Commonwealth and makes such use a primary offense.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

8. Fiscal Implications: Although this legislation may have some revenue impact due to making these violations primary offences, it is impossible to determine the extent of the impact at this time. Any additional civil penalties derived from this legislation will be deposited into the literary fund.
