4. Title: Appointment of members of local soil and water conservation boards.

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the governing body of a county or city in a soil and water conservation district to enact an ordinance requiring that the locality's representatives on the district board be appointed by the governing body rather than elected by the registered voters, as is currently required.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Conservation and Recreation does not anticipate a fiscal impact resulting from this bill.

Any reduction in workload for the State Board of Elections resulting from the bill is anticipated to be minimal.
