4. Title: Insurance for employees and retired employees of localities and other local government entities

5. Summary: The bill would add the employees of boards, commissions, agencies, or authorities that are political subdivisions of the Commonwealth to the list of employees who may receive insurance from a locality. The political subdivision must be working in close cooperation with the locality before the insurance may be provided. Current law limits the provision of such insurance to the employees of boards, commissions, agencies, and authorities that were created or controlled by the locality.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No fiscal impact; final.

8. Fiscal Implications: There would be no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth associated with this bill.
