4. Title: Virginia Child Protection Accountability System

5. Summary: Requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to report information about sentences imposed in cases involving certain criminal violations and requires each juvenile and domestic relations district court to report information about petitions for emergency and preliminary removal and protective orders filed with the court to the Virginia Child Protection Accountability System. An enactment clause calls for the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court (OES) to determine if select information can be retrieved from the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts' Case Management System or the Circuit Court Case Management System. Another enactment clause calls for the OES and the Department of Social Services (DSS) to work together to determine how select information can be retrieved on children who are alleged to have been abused or neglected for inclusion in the Virginia Child Protection Accountability System.
