4. Title: Limitation on Administrative Actions Relating to Firearms Act

5. Summary: SB324 invalidates all administrative actions (regulations and other actions taken by an administrative body) concerning firearms and/or ammunition other than those expressly authorized by statute. It also prohibits future administrative actions concerning firearms and/or ammunition other than those expressly authorized by statute. The bill includes exemptions for several agencies in regulating firearms and/or ammunition in specific delineated areas, but would leave administrative actions concerning firearms and/or ammunition by those agencies subject to invalidation if the action did not fall within the delineated areas.
