3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Weight limits; haulers of sand, gravel, and crushed stone.

5. Summary: This bill extends the temporary increased weight limit for trucks hauling sand, gravel, or crushed stone in coal counties to January 1, 2013. The bill also contains an enactment clause that directs a January 1, 2013 sunset.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Code of Virginia contains many specific exemptions for specific types of overweight trucks, including this exemption for haulers of sand, gravel, and crushed stone. HB806 will eliminate these exemptions and apply one fee structure for all types of overweight trucks. This proposed legislation will extend the exemption for sand, gravel, and crushed stone vehicles until January 1, 2013, when the new fee rate will apply.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Haulers of gravel, sand or crushed stone.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: HB806 carries an effective date of January 1, 2013.
