3. Committee: Passed Senate

4. Title: Fire insurance; earthquake coverage notice.

5. Summary: Fire insurance; earthquake coverage notice. Requires insurers issuing new or renewal policies of fire insurance or fire insurance in combination with other insurance coverages, which exclude coverage for damage caused by earthquake, to provide a written notice that explicitly states that (i) damage caused by earthquake is excluded and (ii) information regarding earthquake insurance is available from the insurer or insurance agent for an additional premium. The notice shall conspicuously state that earthquake coverage *may* be excluded and, if such coverage is available, shall state that information regarding earthquake coverage is available from the insurance company or agent.
