2. Patron: Northam

3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Combined fishing license.

5. Summary: This bill removes references to the specific dollar amounts that each freshwater and saltwater license is sold for and provides that the cost of the combined sportfishing license shall be the sum of the two component licenses. The bill also recognizes that the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries and the Marine Resources Commission currently have the authority to independently establish the price of each of agency's license.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. No Fiscal Impact. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries or the Marine Resources Commission. Currently, the cost of the combined sportfishing license provided by each agency is the sum of the two component licenses. The language established in this bill reinforces current practice. In addition, each agency is only able to adjust the fee of its component license no more than once every three years. It is expected that each agency will have sufficient nongeneral fund appropriation to cover any resulting change in revenue.
