4. Title: Weighing of vehicles.

5. Summary: This bill exempts vehicles owned or leased by the City of Suffolk from being weighed at Department of Motor Vehicles-controlled weigh-stations along U.S. Route 58 in Suffolk.

7. No Fiscal Impact. Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: None.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles, City of Suffolk.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: Pursuant to Virginia Code § 15.2-3530, in 2006 the Virginia Department of Transportation entered into a devolution agreement with the City of Suffolk for the transfer of responsibilities for the construction and maintenance for all streets within the city boundaries. Under the agreement all streets, except I-664, Route 164, and the Route 17-664-164 Rail Corridor, within the boundaries of the city became part of the urban system. Under the terms of the agreement the Route 58 truck scales and all associated equipment (buildings, ramps, parking areas, signage, weigh-in-motion equipment, utility services, and the pedestrian overpass) remained the property and responsibility of the Commonwealth.
