5. Summary: Requires the Commissioner of Health to accept applications and to authorize the Commissioner to issue certificates of public need to establish a psychiatric service and the addition of psychiatric inpatient beds.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of this legislation is minimal. This legislation could generate \$1,000 in additional revenue for the Virginia Department of Health. The additional revenue comes from the minimum fee assessed and collected for the Certificate of Public Need application.

This legislation does not create a fiscal impact for the Department of Medical Assistance Services.
