4. Title: Elections; military and overseas voters.

5. Summary: The enrolled SB 565 reorganizes and improves the current law dealing with the registration and absentee voting procedures for military and overseas voters. The amendments adopt major aspects of model legislation developed by the National Commissioners for Uniform State Laws entitled, "Uniform Military and Overseas Voters Act."

8. Fiscal Implications: State Board of Elections (SBE) indicates that portions of the enrolled bill better organizes current law and agency practice. The SBE also indicates implementation of any new policies can be absorbed by the agency.
