Amends the definition of "life insurance" to provide that policies can include benefits for child care expenses, educational expenses, or other expenses necessary for the support and maintenance of the insured's immediate family. The bill also amends the definition of "accident and sickness insurance" to allow a policy to provide additional benefits including additional benefits for child care expenses or educational expenses in the event the insured suffers such a loss.
