3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Pole attachments; cable television systems and cooperatives.

5. Summary: Pole attachments; electric cooperatives. Authorizes the State Corporation Commission to determine just and reasonable rates, and certain terms and conditions of service, for attachments to electric cooperative poles by telecommunications service providers and cable television systems. The authority may be exercised if, after good faith negotiations, the parties cannot reach an agreement regarding the attachment. Fees may be assessed to allow the Commission to recover appropriate costs of such proceedings.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. The fiscal impact is indeterminate. Final. See Item # 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation will impose additional costs on the Commission. However, the legislation also includes a funding mechanism to defray those costs. Reasonably accurate estimates of the net effects of those additional costs and revenues cannot be developed at this time.
