5. Summary: Requires general registrar to compare list of registered voters for his locality to the State Board of Elections (SBE) comprehensive list of convicted felons, to cancel the registration of any registered voter shown to be a felon, and to notify the registered voter of the cancellation.

8. Fiscal Implications: SBE states that this bill has no fiscal impact because the voter registration system (VERIS) currently compares the list of registered voters to the list of convicted felons. Matched records are provided to the general registrar for processing.
