5 6 WHEREAS, the Lawrenceville Volunteer Fire Department will proudly celebrate 100 years of serving the residents of the Town of Lawrenceville in 2012; and 7

8 WHEREAS, the Town of Lawrenceville, created in 1784 and situated at a crossing of colonial stage 9 coach roads, has long served as the seat of Brunswick County; and

10 WHEREAS, the Town of Lawrenceville grew and prospered over the years, from two churches and 25 dwellings in 1846 to a population of over 300 in 1890; and 11

WHEREAS, the development of St. Paul's College by James Solomon Russell and the completion of 12 13 the Atlantic and Danville Railway Company terminal and its accompanying shops and offices drew 14 railroad workers and students to the area; and

WHEREAS, by 1910, the population of the Town of Lawrenceville had expanded to 1,733 15 individuals; the burgeoning population necessitated the construction of a water plant, wastewater system, 16 and electric generating plant; and 17

WHEREAS, concerned citizens of the Town of Lawrenceville also realized the importance of having 18 19 their own fire company to protect homes and businesses, resulting in the formation of the Lawrenceville 20 Volunteer Fire Department in 1912; and

WHEREAS, for the past 100 years, the Lawrenceville Volunteer Fire Department has battled fires, 21 responded to emergencies, and provided education on fire safety to local residents, while staving abreast 22 23 of the latest changes in technology and equipment; and

24 WHEREAS, the highly trained members of the Lawrenceville Volunteer Fire Department have 25 devoted countless hours to serving the residents of the Town of Lawrenceville with the generous support 26 of community members; now, therefore, be it

27 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates. That the Lawrenceville Volunteer Fire Department hereby 28 be commended on the occasion of its 100th anniversary; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 29 for presentation to the Lawrenceville Volunteer Fire Department as an expression of the House of 30 Delegates' congratulations and appreciation for the department's century of service to the community. 31
