**HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 557**

WHEREAS, Samuel L. Gravely, Jr. Elementary School students undertake a rigorous academic curriculum that is enhanced through technology, writing, and hands-on science experiments and participate in a variety of before and after school clubs; and

WHEREAS, Samuel L. Gravely, Jr. Elementary School students learn about a variety of subjects through the observance of national month designations, such as National Nutrition Month, Women's History Month, and Keep America Beautiful Month; and

WHEREAS, Samuel L. Gravely, Jr. Elementary School students also participated in the Prince William County Art Festival on March 24, 2012, with one student winning the White Ribbon for Best in Show: and
