 member for numerous civic, business, and charitable organizations, including the Alexandria Jaycees,
 local chamber of commerce, Alexandria Legal Aid Society, and Alexandria Bar Foundation; and

WHEREAS, a man of great integrity, Judge Haddock also served as an inspirational role model foryoung men as he volunteered with the Boy Scouts of America; and
