That §§ 2.2-1401 and 2.2-4310 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: § 2.2-1401. Definitions. As used in this chapter unless the context requires a different meaning: "Certification" means the process by which a business is determined to be a small, women-owned, or minority-owned business for the purpose of reporting small, women-owned, and minority-owned business for the purpose of reporting small, women-owned, and minority-owned business for the purpose of reporting small, women-owned, and minority-owned business for the original peoples of the Code of the following definitions: 1. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no public body shall discriminate against a bidder or offeror because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, status as a service disabled veteran, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment. Whenever solicitations are made, each public body shall include businesses selected from a list made available by the Department of Minority Business Enterprise.

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59 B. All public bodies shall establish programs consistent with this chapter to facilitate the participation 60 of small businesses and businesses owned by women, minorities, and service disabled veterans in procurement transactions. The programs established shall be in writing and shall comply with the 61 62 provisions of any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection 63 C or, where applicable, by the chief executive of a local governing body pursuant to § 15.2-965.1, and 64 shall include specific plans to achieve any goals established therein. State agencies shall submit annual 65 progress reports on small, women-women-owned, and minority-owned business procurement and on service disabled veteran-owned business procurement to the Department of Minority Business Enterprise 66 in a form specified by the Department of Minority Business Enterprise. The Department of Minority 67 68 Business Enterprise shall make information on service disabled veteran-owned procurement available to 69 the Department of Veterans Services upon request.

C. Whenever there exists (i) a rational basis for small business enhancement or (ii) a persuasive analysis that documents a statistically significant disparity between the availability and utilization of women-women-owned and minority-owned businesses, the Governor is authorized and encouraged to require state agencies to implement appropriate enhancement or remedial measures consistent with prevailing law.

D. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no state agency, department or institution shall
discriminate against a bidder or offeror because the bidder or offeror employs ex-offenders unless the
state agency, department or institution has made a written determination that employing ex-offenders on
the specific contract is not in its best interest.

E. As used in this section:

80 "Minority individual" means an individual who is a citizen of the United States or a legal resident81 alien and who satisfies one or more of the following definitions:

82 1. "African American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa and83 who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part.

2. "Asian American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East,
Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands, including but not limited to Japan, China,
Vietnam, Samoa, Laos, Cambodia, Taiwan, Northern Mariana, the Philippines, a U.S. territory of the

"Minority-owned business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more minority individuals who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals.

101 "Service disabled veteran" means a veteran who (i) served on active duty in the United States
102 military ground, naval, or air service, (ii) was discharged or released under conditions other than
103 dishonorable, and (iii) has a service-connected disability rating fixed by the United States Department of
104 Veterans Affairs.

105 "Service disabled veteran business" means a business that is at least 51% 51 percent owned by one 106 or more service disabled veterans or, in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability 107 company or other entity, at least 51% 51 percent of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, 108 partnership, or limited liability company or other entity is owned by one or more individuals who are 109 service disabled veterans and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one 110 or more individuals who are service disabled veterans.

"Small business" means a business independently owned and controlled by one or more individuals
who are U.S. citizens or legal resident aliens, and together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees,
or annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the previous three years. One or more of
the individual owners shall control both the management and daily business operations of the small
business that meets the definition of a small business concern as defined in the federal Small Business
Act (15 U.S.C. § 631 et seq.), as amended, and relevant regulations promulgated thereto.

"State agency" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, institution, agency, or otherunit of state government. "State agency" shall not include any county, city, or town.
