6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

That §§ 62.1-69.25, 62.1-69.29, and 62.1-69.30 of the Code of Virginia are amended and 7 1. 8 reenacted as follows: 9

§ 62.1-69.25. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:

10 "Rappahannock River Basin" means that land area designated as the Rappahannock River Basin by 11 12 the State Water Control Board pursuant to § 62.1-44.38 and which is also found in the Fourth, Seventeenth, Twenty-fourth, Twenty-fifth, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-seventh, and Twenty-eighth Senatorial 13 Districts or the Fifteenth, Eighteenth, Twenty-eighth, Thirtieth, Thirty-first, Fifty-fourth, Fifty-eighth, 14 15 Eighty-eighth, Ninety-eighth, and Ninety-ninth House of Delegates Districts, as those districts exist on January 1, 2002 2012. 16 17

§ 62.1-69.29. Membership; terms; vacancies.

18 The membership of the Commission shall consist of 34 32 members, which includes 17 15 19 legislative members and 17 nonlegislative citizen members, to be appointed as follows: 10 nine members of the House of Delegates, one member each of the Fifteenth, Eighteenth, Twenty-eighth, Thirtieth, 20 21 Thirty-first, Fifty-fourth, Fifty-eighth, Eighty-eighth, Ninety-eighth, and Ninety-ninth House of Delegates 22 Districts, as those districts existed on January 1, 2002 2012; seven six members of the Senate, one 23 member each of the Fourth, Seventeenth, Twenty-fourth, Twenty-fifth, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-seventh, 24 and Twenty-eighth Senatorial Districts, as those districts existed on January 1, 2002 2012; one member 25 or designee of each of the 16 governing bodies of the jurisdictions in which not less than two percent of 26 the jurisdiction is found wholly or partially within the Rappahannock River Basin, that at any time pass 27 a resolution containing the language required by § 62.1-69.26, to be appointed by the respective local 28 governing body; and one member or designee of a Soil and Water Conservation District found wholly or 29 partially within the Rappahannock River Basin, to be appointed jointly by the Soil and Water 30 Conservation Districts found wholly or partially within the Rappahannock River Basin. Nonlegislative citizen members of the Commission shall be citizens of the Commonwealth of Virginia. 31

32 All members of the Commission shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. 33 Appointments to fill vacancies, other than by expiration of a term, shall be for the unexpired terms. All 34 members may be reappointed. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. 35

For the purposes of this section, "nonlegislative citizen member" means a member of one of the local governing bodies or the Soil and Water Conservation Districts of the jurisdictions found wholly or 36 37 partially within the Rappahannock River Basin. 38

§ 62.1-69.30. Chairman and vice-chairman; quorum; meetings.

39 The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership. Twelve 40 Eleven members of the Commission shall constitute a quorum. The Commission shall meet no more 41 than four times each year. The meetings of the Commission shall be held at the call of the chairman or 42 whenever the majority of the members so request. Each member of the Commission shall have an equal 43 vote.
