10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 15.2-1127 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 15.2-1127. Vacant building registration; penalty.
13	The Town of Pulaski, in a conservation and rehabilitation district of the town, and any city, by
14	ordinance, may require the owner or owners of buildings that have been vacant for a continuous period
15	of 12 months or more to register such buildings on an annual basis and may impose an annual
16	registration fee not to exceed \$25 \$250 to defray the cost of processing such registration. The
17	
	registration of buildings shall be on forms designated by the locality and filed with the agency
18	designated by the locality. Failure to register shall be a \$50 civil penalty; however, failure to register in

as blighted pursuant to § 36-49.1:1, shall be punishable by a civil penalty not exceeding \$250. Notice shall be mailed to the owner or owners, at the address to which property tax notices are sent, at least 30 20 21 22

days prior to the assessment of the civil penalty.
