A BILL to allow the City of Charlottesville to amend its subdivision ordinance regarding the provision
of sidewalks.
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
1. § 1. The governing body of the City of Charlottesville may, as a part of its subdivision ordinance as
authorized by § 15.2-2242 of the Code of Virginia, include provisions allowing the subdivider or
developer of a residential lot, or of a lot containing at least one residential unit, the option of either (i)
dedicating land for and constructing a sidewalk as specified in subdivision 9 of § 15.2-2242 or (ii)
contributing to a sidewalk fund, maintained and administered by the city, funds equivalent to the cost of
the dedication of land for and construction of a sidewalk on the property. Nothing in this act shall alter
