6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 29.1-740 of the Code of Virginia, relating to duty of certain persons in
7	vessels to report boating accidents; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 29.1-740 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 29.1-740. Duty to stop and render assistance; penalties for violations; reporting of accident by
11	passengers.
12	A. It shall be the duty of every operator of a vessel involved in a collision or accident or other
13	casualty to stop and render assistance as required by subsection A of § 29.1-739. If any person operator
14	knowingly fails to comply with the provisions of subsection A of § 29.1-739 when the collision,
15	accident or other casualty results in serious bodily injury to, or the death of, any person, he shall be is
16	guilty of a Class 6 felony. If any person operator knowingly fails to comply with the provisions of
17	subsection A of § 29.1-739, when the collision, accident or other casualty results only in damage to
18	property, he shall be is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. However, if the vessel struck is unattended and
19	the damage is less than fifty dollars \$50, such person the operator shall be punished only by a fine not
20	exceeding fifty dollars \$50.
21	B. If the operator of a vessel knowingly fails to comply with the provisions of subsection A of
22	§ 29.1-739, every passenger in the vessel who is 18 years of age or older and has knowledge of the
23	collision, accident or other casualty resulting in serious bodily injury to, or the death of, any person
24	shall have a duty to ensure that a report of the occurrence is made to a law-enforcement officer of the

26 subsection B of § 29.1-739. Any such passenger who knows or has reason to know that no such report27 of the occurrence has been made by any other person in the vessel and who fails to report the

28 occurrence to such an officer within 24 hours of the occurrence is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
