10 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, a majority of the members elected to 11 each house agreeing, That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same 12 hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next 13 general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the 14 provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:

15 Amend the Constitution of Virginia by adding in Article I a section numbered 11-A as follows:

ARTICLE I BILL OF RIGHTS

18 Section 11-A. Right to work.

19 That any agreement or combination between any employer and any labor union or labor
20 organization whereby nonmembers of the union or organization are denied the right to work for the
21 employer, or whereby such membership is made a condition of employment or continuation of

employment by such employer, or whereby any such union or organization acquires an employment
monopoly in any enterprise, is against public policy and constitutes an illegal combination or

24 conspiracy.
