WHEREAS, a trusted leader, Dee Dee Darden works with other supervisors and county officials to ensure the efficient and effective operation of local government and services for area residents; and

WHEREAS, an outstanding farm mom who has made tremendous contributions to her family, community, and the agricultural industry in the Commonwealth and nation, Dee Dee Darden is a worthy recipient of this prestigious honor; now, therefore, be it
