WHEREAS, senior Lindsay Lawson was named the Cumberland District's softball player of the year,
 while head coach Suzi Atwood garnered Cumberland District coach of the year honors; and

WHEREAS, Lindsay Lawson, Lindsay Dean, Alana Johnson, Courtney Marrs, Erin Stanley, and
 Samantha Cole were all named to the All-Cumberland District first team; and

WHEREAS, the championship victory was a result of the talent and dedication of all the players, the
leadership of head coach Suzi Atwood, and the support of the Eastside High School community; now,
