## **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 892**

3 Celebrating the life of Ramez Said Azoury, M.D. 4

INTRODUCED WHEREAS, Ramez Said Azoury, M.D., a distinguished physician and a respected educator from Norfolk, died on January 12, 2013; and

WHEREAS, a native of Beirut, Lebanon, Ramez Azoury, the son of Bahía and Said Azoury, was 8 9 educated in Lebanon in the French school systems and became the nation's top Scout while a member of 10 the Lebanese Scouting Federation; and

WHEREAS, Ramez Azoury earned a bachelor's degree and a medical degree from the American 11 University of Beirut and completed a residency there before completing a residency and fellowship in 12 13 the United States at Johns Hopkins University; and

WHEREAS, a highly skilled gynecologic pathologist, Dr. Azoury then returned to the American 14 University of Beirut and served as an associate professor before becoming acting chair of its 15 16 obstetrics-gynecology department; and

WHEREAS, as Lebanon became engulfed in a civil war, Dr. Azoury relocated to the United States 17 and worked briefly at the University of Cincinnati before returning to the American University of Beirut 18 19 as chair of the obstetrics-gynecology department; and

20 WHEREAS, an outstanding physician, Dr. Azoury decided in 1986 to relocate permanently to the 21 United States to protect his wife and four children from the effects of the Lebanese Civil War and made 22 Norfolk his new home; and

23 WHEREAS, Dr. Azoury brought a wealth of experience and expertise to Eastern Virginia Medical 24 School and later became a professor and the director of the obstetrics-gynecology department at DePaul 25 Medical Center in Norfolk; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Azoury not only provided outstanding care to his patients, but served as a mentor 26 27 and leader to many aspiring physicians, which led to his selection as the recipient of the DePaul 28 Medical Center's Award for Excellence in Teaching; and

29 WHEREAS, after touching countless lives during a storied medical career in Lebanon and the United 30 States, Dr. Azoury retired in May 2012; and

31 WHEREAS, Dr. Azoury cared deeply for his patients and his legacy lives on through the knowledge and sense of compassion he passed down to many young doctors in the Commonwealth and around the 32 33 world; and

34 WHEREAS, Dr. Azoury will be lovingly remembered and greatly missed by his devoted wife, 35 Jacqueline; children, Candice, Sharon, Krystle, and Said, and their families; and many other family 36 members, friends, and former colleagues; now, therefore, be it

37 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 38 note with great sadness the loss of a distinguished physician and respected educator, Ramez Said 39 Azoury, M.D.; and, be it

40 RESOLVED FURTHER. That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 41 for presentation to the family of Ramez Said Azoury, M.D., as an expression of the General Assembly's 42 respect for his memory.
