14	Stoner Winslett and acknowledged and supported by the board of trustees; and
15	WHEREAS, the values of the Richmond Ballet are best revealed through the specific choices made
16	regarding the programming philosophy, the performance production values, and the selection of dancers
17	and other artistic staff; and
18	WHEREAS, the Richmond Ballet continues its 54-year commitment to producing performances of
19	the highest quality, keeping meaningful works of dance alive, and producing and fostering new works
20	that remain true to its values; and
21	WHEREAS, the Richmond Ballet also offers dance training and encourages the love of ballet
22	throughout the community with the goal of, above all, awakening and uplifting the human spirit of both
23	audiences and dancers; and
24	WHEREAS, the School of Richmond Ballet offers training for students by a world-class faculty in a
25 26	state-of-the-art facility shared with Richmond Ballet professional company dancers; and WHEREAS, the Richmond Ballet delivers exceptional education and outreach programs, such as
20 27	<i>Minds In Motion</i> , which take the joy and discipline of dance into schools to inspire a new generation of
28	art lovers; and
2 9	WHEREAS, the Richmond Ballet provides a source of civic pride: the very best of dance-classic
30	ballets and contemporary works by the brightest emerging and established choreographers-performed in
31	Richmond by professional dancers, the ultimate artist-athletes; and
32	WHEREAS. the Richmond Ballet is a cultural asset for the entire Commonwealth through the
33	professional company and second company (Richmond Ballet II) performances in schools and on tour
34	throughout the state; and
35	WHEREAS, the Richmond Ballet has gained national and international recognition, having been
36	invited to perform in New York City (at The Joyce Theater in 2005, 2007, and 2010) and London (at
37	the Royal Opera House Linbury Studio Theatre in 2012), considered to be two of the world's dance
38 39	capitals; and WUEDEAS the Dichmond Ballet will make its debut in the nation's capital in June 2012 for the
40	WHEREAS, the Richmond Ballet will make its debut in the nation's capital in June 2013 for the Kennedy Center's biennial Ballet Across America series, which showcases the talent of United States
