13105309D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 950** 1 2 Offered February 18, 2013 3 Commending Washington Mill Elementary School. 4 Patrons—Surovell and Albo; Senators: Ebbin and Puller 5 6 WHEREAS, in 2013 Washington Mill Elementary School in Alexandria will proudly celebrate 50 7 years of providing a quality education to its students in its building; and WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School, built on land once owned by George Washington 8 9 and officially located in the backyard of Mount Vernon, is equally proud of its past, present, and future; 10 and WHEREAS, the land where George Washington once walked continues to serve as a farm and 11 Washington Mill Elementary School draws upon its close proximity for inspiration as it plants the seeds 12 13 of a solid education for its students; and WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School began with an initial school enrollment of 14 15 approximately 250 community students in grades one through six and today has an enrollment of 657 16 students: and WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School underwent a large renovation in 1996 to add an 17 additional hallway and added a 10-room modular facility in 2007 in response to a rapidly growing 18 19 community of families; and 20 WHEREAS, as schools across the nation also began to implement full-day kindergarten, Washington 21 Mill Elementary School began full-day kindergarten classes in the 2003 - 2004 school year; and WHEREAS, over the years, Washington Mill Elementary School continued to stay abreast of 22 23 technological changes, added a playground, and created an English for Speakers of Other Languages 24 program to better meet the needs of its students; and 25 WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School continues to this day to work with students, parents, and the community to offer students a continuum of services to meet each individual's unique 26 27 needs and to maximize their achievement; and WHEREAS, in 2013 Washington Mill Elementary School will implement an English and Spanish 28 29 Immersion Program to develop students' cross-cultural understanding and global perspective; and 30 WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School continues to use the latest technology with the help 31 of its technology specialists; the school has Smart Boards in every classroom and mobile labs available 32 to all grade levels; and 33 WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School also weaves technology into the curriculum, 34 including a computer, curriculum-based math program in grades four through six, while continuing to 35 emphasize basic skills; and 36 WHEREAS, over the years, Washington Mill Elementary School has and continues to offer advanced 37 academic opportunities to identified students from all backgrounds, including the Young Scholars 38 program and full-day programs; it also offers a range of afterschool programs; and 39 WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School enjoys rich diversity in its population and the 40 school community views diversity as a strength that adds to a multicultural educational program; the community also celebrates family heritage through a yearly program focusing on each student's family 41 42 history; and WHEREAS, while the school mascot has remained the Colonials throughout its 50-year history, the 43 44 school colors have changed many times by student vote and are currently red, white, and blue; and WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School supports the parent-teacher association and the 45 46 school community continues to work in partnership to benefit student success and achievement both in 47 the classroom and on the school grounds; and WHEREAS, Washington Mill Elementary School continues to provide an outstanding education to its 48 49 students through dedicated leaders, supportive staff, and devoted teachers; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 50 51 commend Washington Mill Elementary School on the occasion of its 50th anniversary; and, be it 52 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 53 for presentation to Washington Mill Elementary School as an expression of the General Assembly's 54 congratulations and admiration for the school's commitment to its students.
