13105346D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 967** 1 2 Offered February 18, 2013 3 Celebrating the life of Major General Carroll Thackston, USA (Ret.). 4 Patrons-Edmunds and Wright; Senator: Ruff 5 6 WHEREAS, Major General Carroll Thackston, USA (Ret.), the former Adjutant General of the 7 Virginia National Guard and the mayor of the Town of South Boston, died on February 17, 2013; and WHEREAS, a graduate of Virginia Military Institute, Carroll Thackston enjoyed a distinguished 8 military career, serving six years in the United States Army and 35 years in the Virginia National 9 10 Guard: and WHEREAS, Carroll Thackston began his illustrious career with the Virginia National Guard with the 11 12 1173rd Transportation Company, which he served as detachment commander and company commander; 13 and 14 WHEREAS, Carroll Thackston rose through the ranks of the Virginia National Guard, serving as the 15 inspector general, commander of the 116th Support Battalion, state military personnel officer, chief of 16 staff, and assistant adjutant general; and WHEREAS, in 1994 Governor George Allen appointed Major General Thackston Adjutant General 17 of the Virginia National Guard, a position he held until 1998; and 18 19 WHEREAS, as Adjutant General, Major General Thackston provided strong leadership to the 20 Virginia National Guard as its members valiantly served at home and abroad to ensure the security of 21 the Commonwealth and the defense of the United States; and 22 WHEREAS, Major General Thackston provided encouraging words as he visited Virginia National 23 Guard members engaged in state emergency response operations and stationed in such locations as 24 Bosnia and Iraq; and 25 WHEREAS, Major General Thackston oversaw the transition of Virginia National Guard operations 26 to Fort Pickett, the installation that today serves as a world-class military, public safety, and civilian 27 educational facility; and 28 WHEREAS, after retiring from the Virginia National Guard, Major General Thackston continued to 29 serve the public as a town council member and mayor of the Town of South Boston, where he worked 30 diligently to ensure the efficient and effective operation of local government; and 31 WHEREAS, Carroll Thackston also once worked as a locomotive fireman and engineer with Norfolk and Western Railroad and manager of the Virginia Employment Commission in South Boston; he retired 32 33 as the human resources manager at Daystrom Furniture; and 34 WHEREAS, a remarkable public servant, Major General Thackston will be remembered for his 35 faithful service and greatly missed by many loving family members, friends, the residents of South 36 Boston, members of the Virginia National Guard, and a grateful Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it 37 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 38 note with great sadness the loss of a true patriot and dedicated public servant, Major General Carroll 39 Thackston, USA (Ret.); and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER. That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 40 41 for presentation to the family of Major General Carroll Thackston, USA (Ret.), as an expression of the 42 General Assembly's respect for his memory.
