 Goodridge contributed to projects on women's health and independence, micro-loans, and population
 studies; and

20 Engagement, and Social Action Linking Together; and

WHEREAS, an active member of Saint Charles Borromeo Catholic Church, Gail Goodridge
 organized church outreach programs in Africa, Haiti, and the Dominican Republic; and

WHEREAS, predeceased by her husband of 18 years, Glyne, Gail Goodridge is survived by her
stepdaughters, Elizabeth, Angela, Renata, and Jennifer, and their families; her mother, Dolores; and
