Commending Grant Bradley.

WHEREAS, exemplifying the honorable ideals of the Boy Scouts of America, Grant Bradley has shown responsibility, integrity, and dedication; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That Grant Bradley hereby be commended for earning the rank of Eagle Scout in the Boys Scouts of America; and, be it
