HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 184

Commending Brambleton.

Agreed to by the House of Delegates, February 15, 2013

WHEREAS, Brambleton, a beautiful master-planned community in Loudoun County, received a Silver Award in the 2013 Nationals, an awards ceremony sponsored by the National Sales and Marketing Council; and

WHEREAS, the Nationals awards, presented by the National Sales and Marketing Council of the National Association of Home Builders, honor outstanding communities, neighborhoods, and individuals each year; as a Silver Award winner, Brambleton was a finalist for the Gold Award; and

WHEREAS, Brambleton received the Silver Award in the Community of the Year category and was also recognized in the Best Landscape Design category; and

WHEREAS, officially opened in 2001, the community of Brambleton, conveniently located just off the Dulles Toll Road, has grown rapidly over the years, becoming an acclaimed mixed-use planned community with close to 10,000 residents; and

WHEREAS, in 2003 Brambleton earned its first Finest for Family Living award, establishing itself as a phenomenal place to raise a family in Northern Virginia; the community has gone on to win many other awards; and

WHEREAS, the state-of-the-art Brambleton Town Center is the site of many events, such as farmers markets and the Sizzlin' Summer Concerts series, and is the heart of the award-winning community; and

WHEREAS, with picturesque, landscaped streets leading to bustling offices and stores, lush public parks, scenic ponds and trails, a full-sized movie theater, and well-maintained athletic facilities and sports fields, Brambleton offers nearly everything its residents might need in their daily lives; and

WHEREAS, Brambleton celebrated its 10th anniversary in 2011 and finished the year as the sixth top-selling master-planned community in the nation with 454 new home sales; and

WHEREAS, today, Brambleton continues to grow and remains one of the premier master-planned communities in Northern Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Brambleton residents make many valuable contributions to the Commonwealth as they work in a variety of professions and businesses and contribute to their local communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That Brambleton hereby be commended on receiving a 2013 Nationals Silver Award from the National Sales and Marketing Council; and, be it
