AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee for Courts of Justice
on February 15, 2013)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator McDougle)

A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-174 of the Code of Virginia, relating to impersonating a law-enforcement officer; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 18.2-174 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 18.2-174. Impersonating officer.

Any person who ~~shall falsely assume or exercise~~ *falsely assumes or exercises* the functions, powers, duties, and privileges incident to the office of sheriff, police officer, marshal, or other peace officer *or those of a federal law-enforcement officer named in clause (iii) of subsection K of § 18.2-308*, or who ~~shall falsely assume or pretend~~ *falsely assumes or pretends* to be any such officer, ~~shall be deemed is~~ guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
