A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates for the U.S. Navy and U.S. Air Force.

Patrons—Puller; Delegate: Krupicka

Referred to Committee on Transportation

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

10 1. That § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

\$ 46.2-743. Special license plates for members of the Virginia Defense Force, certain veterans,
 and active duty members of the Marine Corps, Army, Navy, and Air Force; fees.

A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of
persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
plates under this subsection.

C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
incorporates an emblem of the United States Army.

D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
United States Navy, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
incorporates an emblem of the United States Navy.

30 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
31 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the
32 United States Air Force, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
33 design incorporates an emblem of the United States Air Force.

34 D. F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War
35 II, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of
36 license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed
37 cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued.

38 E. G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean **39** War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.

40 F. H. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
41 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.

42 G. I. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the 43 Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that 44 campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in 45 addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are 46 issued.

47 H. J. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
48 Iraqi Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation Iraqi
49 Freedom.

50 I. K. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
 51 Enduring Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation
 52 Enduring Freedom.

J. L. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Virginia
 Defense Force, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the Virginia Defense
 Force.

56 K. M. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation

57 Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans

58 of those military operations.

59 L. N. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates 60 issued under subsection A, D, E, F, H, I, J, or K of this section *except those issued under subsection I*.
