43 Of such Board, one member shall be a resident of the territory now included in the Bristol construction district, one in the Salem construction district, one in the Lynchburg construction district, 44 one in the Staunton construction district, one in the Culpeper construction district, one in the 45 Fredericksburg construction district, one in the Richmond construction district, one in the Hampton 46 47 Roads construction district and one in the Northern Virginia construction district each congressional district in the Commonwealth, as those congressional districts are configured as of the date of that **48** 49 *member's appointment*. The remaining five four members shall be appointed from the Commonwealth at 50 large, but at least two shall reside in standard metropolitan statistical areas and be designated as urban 51 at-large members, and at least two shall reside outside standard metropolitan statistical areas and be designated as rural at-large members. The at-large members shall be appointed to represent rural and 52 53 urban transportation needs and be mindful of the concerns of seaports and seaport users, airports and 54 airport users, railways and railway users, and mass transit and mass transit users. Each member so appointed shall be mindful of the best interest of the Commonwealth at large primarily instead of those 55 of the district from which chosen or of the transportation interest represented.

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Transportation

on January 25, 2012)

(Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Petersen)

A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 33.1-1 and 33.1-2 of the Code of Virginia, relating to composition of

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 33.1-1 and 33.1-2 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

10 § 33.1-1. State Highway and Transportation Board continued as Commonwealth Transportation Board; number and terms of members; removal from office; Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner continued as Commissioner of Highways; vacancies. 11 12

The State Highway and Transportation Board, formerly known as the State Highway and 13 14 Transportation Commission, is continued and shall hereafter be known as the Commonwealth Transportation Board. Wherever either "Commission" or "Board" is used in this title referring to the 15 State Highway and Transportation Board or the State Highway and Transportation Commission, it shall 16 17 mean the Commonwealth Transportation Board.

18 The Board shall consist of seventeen 18 members: the Secretary of Transportation, the Commissioner 19 of Highways, the Director of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation, and fourteen 15 citizen 20 members. The citizen members shall be (i) appointed by the Governor as provided in § 33.1-2, (ii) 21 subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, and (iii) removable from office during their respective 22 terms by the Governor at his pleasure. Appointments of citizen members shall be for terms of four years 23 commencing upon July 1, upon the expiration of the terms of the existing members, respectively. The 24 initial terms of the members appointed in January, 1987, shall commence when appointed and shall be for terms ending June 30, 1988, June 30, 1989, and June 30, 1990, respectively. Vacancies shall be 25 filled by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired term and shall be effective until 30 days after 26 27 the next meeting of the ensuing General Assembly and, if confirmed, thereafter for the remainder of the term. No person shall be eligible to serve more than two successive terms of four years, other than the 28 29 Secretary of Transportation, the Commissioner of Highways, and the Director of the Department of Rail 30 and Public Transportation. A person heretofore or hereafter appointed to fill a vacancy may serve two 31 32

The Secretary of Transportation shall serve as Chairman of the Board. The Secretary shall have voting privileges only in the event of a tie. The Commissioner of Highways shall serve as 33 34 Vice-Chairman of the Board. The Commissioner shall have voting privileges only in the event of a tie 35 when he is presiding during the absence of the Chairman. The Director of the Department of Rail and 36 Public Transportation shall serve without a vote.

37 Whenever in this title and in the Code of Virginia "State Highway Commission" or "State Highway 38 and Transportation Board" is used, it shall mean "Commonwealth Transportation Board"; "State Highway Commissioner" or "State Highway and Transportation Commissioner" or "Commonwealth 39 Transportation Commissioner" shall mean Commissioner of Highways; and all references to "Department 40 41 of Highways and Transportation" shall refer to the Department of Transportation. 42
