10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That §§ 46.2-665 and 46.2-666 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: § 46.2-665. Vehicles used for agricultural or horticultural purposes.
12	A. No person shall be required to obtain the registration certificate, license plates and decals, or pay
13	a registration fee for any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer used exclusively for agricultural or
15	horticultural purposes on lands owned or leased by the vehicle's owner.
16	B. This exemption shall only apply to (i) pickup trucks, (ii) or panel trucks, (iii) (ii) sport utility
17	vehicles, (iv) (<i>iii</i>) vehicles having a gross vehicle weight rating greater than 7,500 pounds, and (v) (<i>iv</i>)
18	trailers and semitrailers that are not operated on or over any public highway in this the Commonwealth
19	for any purpose other than:
20	1. Crossing a highway;
21	2. Operating along a highway for a distance of no more than thirty 50 miles from one part of the
22	owner's land to another, irrespective of whether the tracts adjoin;
23	3. Taking the vehicle or attached fixtures to and from a repair shop for repairs;
24	4. Taking another vehicle exempt from registration under any provision of §§ 46.2-664 through
25	46.2-668 or § 46.2-672, or any part or subcomponent of such a vehicle, to or from a repair shop for
26	repairs, including return trips;
27	5. Operating along a highway to and from a refuse disposal facility for the purpose of disposing of
28	trash and garbage generated on a farm; or
29 30	6. Operating along a highway for a distance of no more than thirty 50 miles for the purpose of
30 31	obtaining supplies for agricultural or horticultural purposes, seeds, fertilizers, chemicals, or animal feed and returning.
31 32	§ 46.2-666. Vehicles used for seasonal transportation of farm produce and livestock.
32 33	No person shall be required to obtain the registration certificate, license plates, and decals, or pay a
34	registration fee prescribed for any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer owned by the owner or lessee of
35	a farm and used by him on a seasonal basis in transporting farm produce and livestock along public
36	highways for a distance of no more than thirty 50 miles or including the distance to the nearest storage
37	house, packing plant, or market, but in no event more than fifty miles. The provisions of this section
38	shall only apply to (i) pickup trucks, (ii) or panel trucks, (iii) (ii) sport utility vehicles, (iv) (iii) vehicles
39	having a gross vehicle weight rating greater than 7,500 pounds, and (v) (iv) trailers and semitrailers.
