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11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 2.2-2101, as it is currently effective and as it shall become effective, of the Code of
13	Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
14	§ 2.2-2101. (Effective until July 1, 2013) Prohibition against service by legislators on boards,
15	commissions, and councils within the executive branch; exceptions.
16	Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards, commissions, and councils
17	within the executive branch of state government who are responsible for administering programs
18	established by the General Assembly. Such prohibition shall not extend to boards, commissions, and
19	councils engaged solely in policy studies or commemorative activities. If any law directs the
20	appointment of any member of the General Assembly to a board, commission, or council in the
21	executive branch of state government that is responsible for administering programs established by the
22	General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall appoint another
23	person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position.
24	The provisions of this section shall not apply to members of the Board for Branch Pilots, who shall
25	be appointed as provided for in § 54.1-901; to members of the Board of Trustees of the Southwest
26	Virginia Higher Education Center, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 23-231.3; to members of

49 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards, commissions, and councils 50 within the executive branch of state government who are responsible for administering programs established by the General Assembly. Such prohibition shall not extend to boards, commissions, and 51 councils engaged solely in policy studies or commemorative activities. If any law directs the 52 53 appointment of any member of the General Assembly to a board, commission, or council in the 54 executive branch of state government that is responsible for administering programs established by the 55 General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall appoint another person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position. 56
